LEARNING AGREEMENT

The incoming Erasmus student should choose the courses to attend before his/her arrival. Usually the Erasmus coordinator in your University is able to suggest, on the basis of the experience of former students, a set of courses best suited for Erasmus (e.g. those involving field work, lab activities, etc).

DEPARTMENT AND CLASSES

The career of a student Natural and Environmental Sciences spreads through 5 years

- Laurea Triennale in Scienze della Natura e dell'Ambiente, is the basic degree that develops on 3-years;
- two alternative advanced degrees, Laurea Magistrale: 1) Scienze ambientali and 2) Scienze della Natura, both with a biennium that can be attended after that the 1st degree has been achieved. This latter limitation does not hold for Erasmus students that might choose their courses freely, supervised from the Coordinator/Professor.
