Andrea Cipollina is a Chemical Engineer and Assistant Professor in 'Chemical Process Design' at the University of Palermo. His scientific activity focuses on three areas - Water & Energy Technology, Mixing, and Green Chemistry. He is joint coordinator of a number of national and international research projects on RE & Desalination, Solar Membrane Distillation and Energy Production.

He is coordinator of an agreement between the Department of Chemical, Management, Mechanical and IT Engineering and the Regional Department of Waste and Water Management to provide technical/scientific assistance in the management and modernization of desalination plants throughout Sicily.

Dr Cipollina is also an expert member of numerous committees and international projects. He has published over 80 papers in scientific journals and international conferences, he holds a patent and is referee for a number of ISI journals.
