Steps to find courses

1. Click on “Vorlesungsverzeichnis”.
2. Choose in the left bar in which semester you want to attend courses at the University of Hamburg. The fixed courses for the coming semester are published a few weeks before the semester starts. However, the course offers are generally repeated every “Sommer-” and “Wintersemester”.
3. Click on “Fakultät für Erziehungswissenschaft” to open the modules of the Faculty of Education.
4. Click on “Erziehungswissenschaft”.
5. Choose the study cycle (Bachelor, Master, PhD).
6. You will find a whole list of all modules that are offered in your study year/ semester and according to the study cycle you chose. If you click on any of them you will find the components of the modules and further a list of courses showing you the type of course (lecture or seminar), the teacher, the day of the week, place and time it takes place.

Important information for the Learning Agreement

- You need to send the Preliminary Learning Agreement with the chosen courses via mail to us (for example: Deadline for the winter semester 2018/19 is end of July).
- The hours in the semester per course are described in SWS (*Semesterwochenstunden*) -2 SWS=1 ECTS, 4 SWS=2 ECTS.
- For each course you have visited, you will receive 2-4 ECTS (for participation 2ECTS, for a homework/test 3-4 ECTS).
