

Giampiero Spalluto received his degree in Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technology in 1987 from the University of Ferrara. He obtained the Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from the University of Parma in 1992.

Between 1995 and 1998 he was Assistant Professor of Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Ferrara. Since November 1998 to the 20 December 2012, he has held the position of Associate Professor of Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Trieste.

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His scientific interests have focused on the enantioselective synthesis of natural compounds and the structure activity relationships of ligands for adenosine receptor subtypes and antitumor agents and more recently on Kinase inhibitors. He is authors of more than 180 articles published in international peer-reviewed journals.
