The University of Palermo (UNIPA), established in 1806 by Ferdinand III of Bourbon, is to date one of the largest universities in Italy and indeed the largest in Sicily.

Palermo, the ancient capital of Sicily, well known for its sea, rich in precious monumental art treasures and the mild climate, favours an intense cultural and artistic life. A natural bridge between Europe and the Mediterranean countries, linked to them by ship, plane, train,

it provides motivation and growth opportunities for young people.



It is a competition with awards, promoted by the University of Palermo with the organizational support of the ARCA Consortium and SINTESI, among groups of people who work out innovative entrepreneurial ideas based on scientific research.

It awards money prizes to the best business ideas expressed in the form of a business plan.

The aim is to support research and technological innovation geared towards economic development in Sicily, by spreading business culture throughout the Region, especially in the academic and professional sectors traditionally distant from the world of business.
