Subjects

Administration

This subject area proposes a degree in "Administration, Organization Sciences and Labour Consultancy" and two master degrees: "Administrations and Complex Organizations Sciences" and "Sustainable development of public and private organizations" (Interuniversity course). The degree provides basic, methodological, cultural, scientific and professional knowledge for legal, economic, political, institutional and organizational management training, in the field of public administration, business administration, as well as labour consultancy. Master degrees provides advanced level knowledge and multidisciplinary methodological skills in the political, institutional, social, economic, legal, managerial disciplines suitable to train professionals of high planning, organization and development capacity of qualified activities of public and private services, specialist expertise in key areas of the administration and a critical, comparative and practical, analysis of the issues related to the administration in the public and private sectors.

International Cooperation and Tourism

This subject area offers two economic courses. The course in "Economic development and international cooperation" provides the tools necessary for the understanding of issues relating to economic growth and sustainable development, the fight against poverty and innovation and change of socio-economic systems. The fundamental skills of the course concern both the economic and cooperative sphere, both the sociological dimension and processes of political change. The course in "Tourism sciences" aims to train people with high skills and appropriate tools to operate in the field of tourism, able to design and implement policies to the qualification of tourism, with particular reference to the enhancement of cultural and environmental heritage as well as to operate in managerial perspective within companies and institutions.

Sports and Motor Activities Management

This subject area provides a degree in "Motor activities and sports sciences" and two master degrees in "Sciences and techniques of sports activities" and "Sports and motor activities management".
The degree aims to give students a solid grounding in the field of physical activities and sports. The master degree in "Sciences and techniques of sports activities" aims to provide expertise on both the theory and methodology of training and evaluation in sports and the theory, technique and teaching of various sports disciplines. The master degree in "Sports and motor activities management" aims to provide specific expertise in the legal and economic institutes proper of physical activities and sports system.

Law studies

This subject area provides the integrated master degree in "Law", in Palermo, Agrigento e Trapani. The course trains lawyers to access the traditional legal professions (judge, notary, lawyer) or careers in public institutions, as well as corporate lawyer and expert in financial markets. Students must attend an admission exam, which consists of a multiple choice test in the subject areas: logic and fundamental philosophical concepts, legal and economic issues, ancient medieval modern and contemporary history. The program is characterized by private, penal, public, trial and philosophical-historical subjects. The course counts Erasmus mobility agreements with over than 25 partner universities and more mobility programs with China and Brazil.

Professional opportunities

Degrees

Graduates may work as a labour consultant, expert on issues of labour/union activities, manager in public administrations, companies, businesses, non-governmental organizations and the voluntary sector, development agent and cooperation expert. They may be professionals in management and organization of welcome, hospitality and tour operator institutions, travel agencies, convention and marketing agencies. They may be professionals in motor-sports education in private and public institutions.

Master degrees

Postgraduates may perform law professions (judge, notary, lawyer), become officials and managers in administrations of national, Community and international administrations, of local public institutions and associations, institutions, private foundations with public connotation. They may operate in management, contract, sports justice sectors, plan/coordinate/perform technical-sportive competitive and non-competitive activities.
