THE SUBJECT OF RESEARCH

The designed and proposed project by the University of Palermo, elaborated by the Professor Ignazia Bartholini, foresees a dual plan with a theoretical and practical application that has the following macro-objectives;

- Create a national and international network of support to the social services, health departments, Municipality with reception centres, law enforcement, and also non-profit organizations working with victims of violence;*
- To allow a multidisciplinary management of the “damage” provoked on the victims (women, men and minors, who are refugees/asylum seeker victims of violence).*

Following these purposes, the project identifies as necessary under the operational plan::

- 1. The elaboration of an intervention handbook;*
- 2. The training of professionals (doctors, social workers, psychologist, law enforcement, etc.), in order to enhance their own capacities and to apply them in specific situations;*
- 3. The monitoring of a restricted number of women, men and minors that are refugee/asylum seeker victims of violence);*
- 4. The dissemination of the best practices that are elaborated and applied at a local, national and international level.*

SUMMARY GUIDELINES OF THE PROJECT

Tackling gender based violence and any form of violence of proximity against refugees/asylum seekers that disembark the Europe’s Mediterranean coasts is the main scope of the project PROVIDE. The project, through a comparative research based on mixed methods has the task to enhance the specific activities of networking as well as the peculiar professional competences in the field of care and the social policies.

*The nucleus of the project’s activity is to develop a **PROTOCOL** containing a **TRAINING METHODOLOGY** with **OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES** addressing all professionals (in particular, social workers, health professionals, law enforcement) and this will be the result of a pilot experiment in all countries of the involved partners.*
