

Please note that accessibility is our top priority. All spaces, buildings, rooms, and events are accessible for all participants!

#### **INSIDE THE CAMPUS:**

- Please note that two free shuttle buses go up and down the Campus from 08.00 to 18.00 daily. Get off at the Building 15 stop for both Buildings 15 & 17. To reach Building 17, please use the pedestrian subway of Building 16, and you will reach Teatro Gregotti on foot in less than 5 minutes.

#### **HOW TO GET HERE:**

- Railway: Station Palazzo Reale-Orleans (Royal Palace of Orleans) on the Palermo Central Station Palermo Airport line, trains from 04.00 to 00.30 daily, two trains per hour in both directions, single tickets can be bought on the Trenitalia website and app.
- Bus: The closest bus stop is called "Basile Artale" on Viale Basile. These are the buses that stop here: 104, 108, 109, 118, 234, 304, 309. When you get off the bus, just enter the Campus from the gate, less than a minute on foot, and then walk towards Buildings 15 & 17. AMAT is the public company that runs the services. The prices are 1.40 € for a single ticket, 3.50 € for a 24-hour ticket, 6.00 € for a 2-day ticket, and 8.00 € for a 3-day ticket. You can also buy tickets on the PalerMobilità app, where you can find discount fares (0.50 € for a single ticket within the city and 1.00 € for a single ticket to the Mondello beach). To check all bus routes, just use the Google Maps app—it works perfectly.
- Taxi: if you want to use a taxi, please note that taxis can enter the Campus and they can leave you in front of both buildings 15 & 17. To avoid scams, use the UBER app. Otherwise, if you take a standard white taxi, remember to ask to turn on the taximeter and if they accept payment by debit or credit cards before boarding the car.
- E-scooter and bike sharing: you can catch an e-scooter or an electric bike. You can use one of the following apps: Bird, Dott, Helbiz, or Uber/Lime.
- From Palermo Central Station, you can catch buses 109 or 234 or use the train. Please note that tickets are different for trains (Trenitalia) and buses (AMAT).
- From Palermo Notarbartolo Station, you can catch bus 118 or use the train. Please note that tickets are different for trains (Trenitalia) and buses (AMAT).

# **Good to know**



#### **CATERING PROVIDED BY I CUCCI.**

Piazza Bologni, 3, Palermo

- Coffee Breaks and Lunches will take place in the garden of Building 15 (ground floor, in front of the building's main entrance). In case of bad weather, the catering will be moved to the pedestrian subway of Building 16.

#### **WEATHER AND WATER:**

- Please do expect high temperatures of around 35 degrees Celsius.
- On the university campus, there are several "Case dell'Acqua" (water dispensers) where you can take cold filtered water for free, both still and sparkling. Please bring your own bottle. The closest water dispenser is in front of the main entrance of Building 15.



#### **SUN, SEA, AND BEACH:**

- Even though Palermo is a city by the sea, there are no beaches in the town, nor can you swim. The closest beach (which is also the most popular one) is called "Mondello", you can easily go there by bus (there are many different lines that go there, but just a few are direct services). Buses run on a 24/7 schedule.
- If you prefer less crowded beaches nearby, we suggest you catch the train of the Palermo Centrale-Palermo Airport line and alight at one of the following stations: "Sferracavallo", "Isola delle Femmine" (which is not an island, despite its name), or "Capaci", tickets on the Trenitalia website and app.
- Otherwise, if you want to travel a bit further out, the most popular destination is the city of Cefalù (45 minutes by train), timetable and tickets on the Trenitalia website and app.
