Art.2 Admission requirements

- For the mobility to FTU: Students currently enrolled (or about to be enrolled) in the first year of the MA in International LM-52 program, curriculum TRADE and STUDIES, for the Spring semester a.y. 2023/24.
- For the mobility to UM: Students currently enrolled (or about to be enrolled) in the first year of the MA in International LM-52 program, curriculum TRADE and STUDIES, for the Spring semester a.y. 2023/24.
- For the mobility to UM: Students currently enrolled (or about to be enrolled) in the first year of the MA in International LM-52 program, curriculum STUDIES, for the Fall semester a.y. 2024/25.

Art.3 Submission of applications

Students can submit only one application.

The student must add an IBAN attached to a personal account where the potential financial support will be deposited. The eventual support will not be deposited if the IBAN is linked to: foreign accounts, prepaid cards of which the student is not the holder, prepaid cards with no IBAN, prepaid cards with IBAN which require authorization codes. Moreover, the student shall make sure the IBAN is not linked to accounts that do not allow deposits over a certain amount. The application must be sent to <u>didatticadems@unipa.it</u> with all the attachments by **November 4th**, **2023 at 12:00 pm**. The e-mail subject line must state: "**Name_Surname_Request for participation to the PIS FTU_UM Program**".

The application e-mail must **include** the following: CV, valid government issued ID or passport, and motivation letter to take part to the program, language certificate (if available)

Minimum language level: English B2

The interviews, which are **mandatory**, will take place **in person**. The applicants must show a valid ID document; if not, the applicant will be disqualified from the process. The interviews will take place on **November 6th 2023 at 2 pm (Venue: Department of Political Science and International Relations – Via U.A. Amico n. 2, Palermo-Italy)**

Art. 4 Financial support and insurance

Successful applicants, before departure, will receive through their university email, the "Contratto" (Mobility Agreement), where in they will find the established dates of their exchange, a code of conduct, academic requirements and grant details.
