## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students who obtained a B.A. in the following subjects are admitted to the course:

- Political science
- Social science
- Economy and management
- Foreign languages
- History
- International relations
- Sociology
- International cooperation
- Administrative studies
- Law
- Engineering

English language proficiency level B2 (fluency in both writing and speaking) is required. Students holding a B.A. in the abovementioned areas obtained in Italy can prove their knowledge showing that they passed the exam in English language ( $6 \mathrm{credits)} \mathrm{in} \mathrm{their} \mathrm{course}$. European students and extra U.E. students holding a B.A. or baccalaureate or similar in the abovementioned areas can prove their knowledge of the English language showing they passed an exam in English language in their course.

In any case, for European and extra U.E. students who attended their courses in English, it is sufficient to show their final degree obtained in English
