Description

The Master of Arts in International Relations, Politics & Trade is a course ENTIRELY held in ENGLISH and on line, organized over a 2-year timeframe.

MAIR on line is offered in synchronous and asynchronous mode, through the dedicated e-learning University of Palermo's platform based on Moodle, accessible anytime, anywhere. It combines traditional lectures with stimulating and dynamic activities, through workshops and a series of practical activities held by academics and professionals. Selected students are also offered the chance of attending our Path of Excellence, a series of seminars and events involving leading experts in international politics and relations. In compliance with the law, exams are held in person.

Program overview

MAIR on line offers the opportunity to understand and appreciate the dynamics of international business through a multidisciplinary approach, from a legal, historical, economic and political perspective. The course is open both to professionals already working and students, who are eager to deepen their knowledge in this complex but fascinating field. To enrich the experience, national and international experts and economic operators are invited for conferences, webinars and other similar events.

Learning outcomes and career opportunities

The course is designed to provide a deep understanding in international economics and relations, international business law, and business cultures. Participants are expected to obtain an advanced knowledge in planning and implementing import/export operations and foreign trade activities and investments. They will be able to draft international contracts, to analyze country risk profiles for foreign investments, and more. The placement opportunities run widely in the international trade sector and include: export managers; international commercial agents; logistics managers; international supply chain managers; specialists in marketing and acquisition of g&s; freight and custom forwarders/brokers; international business developers; public officials in charge of public procurement, international relations and foreign trade; business intelligence analysts.

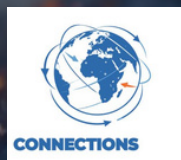
