The course is entirely taught in **English (B2 level)** in **synchronous** and **asynchronous** mode over a 2-year timeframe.

Program overview

The Master of Arts in International Relation. Politics&Trade (MAIR-online) is an entirely online course which offers both professionals and students the opportunity to deepen their knowledge on the dynamics of international business in a multidisciplinary approach. Indeed, the complexity of doing business at a global level is addressed by academics from a legal, historical, economic and political perspective.

To enrich the experience, national and international experts and economic operators are invited for conferences, webinars and other similar events.

Learning outcomes and career opportunities

The course has been designed to deliver a deep understanding in international economics and relations, international business law, and business cultures. Participants are expected to obtain an advanced knowledge in planning and implementing import/export operations foreign trade and activities and investments, being able to draft international contracts. to analyse country risk profiles for foreign investments, and more.

The placement opportunities run widely in the international trade and include: sector export managers; international commercial logistics agents; managers; international supply chain managers; specialists in marketing and acquisition of q&s; freight and forwarders/brokers; custom international business developers; public officials in charge of public procurement, international relations foreign trade: business and intelligence analysts.
