**CALL FOR THE AWARDING OF NO. 10 SCHOLARSHIPS IN THE AMOUNT OF
€3,500.00 EACH FOR STUDENTS ADMITTED TO THE FIRST YEAR OF
THE DEGREE PROGRAMME IN “MIGRATION, RIGHTS, INTEGRATION”
(LM/90) ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026**

Art. 1 Number and Amount of the Scholarships

1. The Department of Law of the University of Palermo announces, for the academic year 2025/2026, a competition for the awarding of no. 10 (ten) scholarships, for students admitted to the first year, and for the first time, of the Degree Programme in “*Migration, Rights, Integration*” (LM/90).
2. The total amount allocated by the Department for this purpose is €35,000.00 (no. **10 scholarships of €3,500.00 each**). Should the number of scholarships awarded be fewer than no. 10 and, therefore, the total amount of €35,000.00, any possible surplus shall be distributed among the winners in equal parts, up to the **maximum amount of €5,000.00 per scholarship**.

Art. 2 Admission Requirements

1. Students enrolled in the Degree Programme in “Migration, Rights, Integration” (LM/90), in the first year in the academic year 2025/26, or admitted to the same Programme and awaiting completion of enrolment for justified reasons, and who have a current ISEE income equal to or lower than €30,000.00 (thirty thousand/00), may participate in the competition.
2. Students who are already beneficiaries of ERSU scholarships or of another scholarship for the same period are excluded from the competition.
3. Should a student awarded the scholarship referred to in this competition subsequently be awarded an ERSU Scholarship or another similar scholarship, they must choose which scholarship they intend to retain. In the event that they opt for the ERSU Scholarship or another scholarship, they shall forfeit the scholarship referred to in this competition, with the



obligation to return the sums (if already received) within 30 days from the disbursement of the first instalment, share, or portion, however denominated, of the ERSU Scholarship.

Art. 3 Application for Participation

1. Applications to participate in the Competition must be submitted, under penalty of exclusion, exclusively by e-mail, by **12:00 on 09/03/2026**, to the address: cdlm.migrazioni@unipa.it
2. The application must be attached to the e-mail message, in “.pdf” format, duly signed with a digital signature/qualified electronic signature, or printed, signed with a legible signature, scanned and attached to the e-mail.
3. The following documents must be attached to the application, under penalty of exclusion:
 - a. Copy of a valid identity document/passport
 - b. Substitute declaration of certification and/or affidavit pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, certifying the degree mark and possession of the requirements for admission to the selection;
 - c. Valid ISEE certification, with specific reference to benefits for the rights to university study (so-called ISEE University).
4. The application may also indicate the IBAN of a bank account, in the name of the candidate (also non-exclusively), into which the scholarship will be credited, once the candidate has completed the enrolment procedure.
5. Only international students who are unable to obtain the ISEE University certification may submit other equivalent documentation (so-called equivalent ISEE). It is recommended to contact CAF offices or the University International Students Office / COT in order to proceed with its determination.

Art. 4 Selection Committee

1. For the awarding of the Scholarship, a Committee shall be appointed within ten days after the expiry of the deadline for the submission of applications. The Committee shall be appointed by the Council of the Department of Law and shall be composed of three members, selected from among Professors and Researchers in service at the Department,



and one member of the technical-administrative staff, with the functions of secretary.

Art. 5 Selection Criteria

1. The scholarship shall be awarded, following the formation of a ranking list, according to the following criteria:

- a) Lower ISEE University (or equivalent ISEE);
- b) in the event of a tie, preference shall be given to the candidate who had residence, prior to admission to the Degree Programme, in a non-EU country considered particularly poor (Decree of the Ministry of University and Research no. 440 of 13 February 2024 – [LIST A](#)) or, subordinately, residence prior to admission to the Degree Programme in a non-EU country with per capita income lower than the world average ([LIST B](#)) or, further subordinately, residence prior to admission to the Degree Programme in other non-EU countries;
- c) in the event of a further tie, preference shall be given to the younger student;
- d) in the event of a further tie, preference shall be given to the student with the higher degree mark;
- e) in the event of a further tie, a draw shall be carried out.

Art. 6 Payment of the Scholarships

1. The Scholarship shall be credited in two instalments of equal amount, after deduction of any tax and social security withholdings (where applicable), to the bank account that will be provided by the winner once the enrolment procedure in the Degree Programme has been completed. In the event of the opening of a new bank account or modification of the IBAN, the updated details must be communicated in the same manner provided for the submission of the application.

2. The first instalment shall be paid, as an advance, subject to verification of the completed enrolment of the scholarship winner; the second instalment shall be paid, as a balance, provided that the student has obtained a number of academic credits equal to half of those required for the first year of the Programme (30 CFU).



Art. 7 Funds for the Disbursement of the Scholarships

1. The funds for the disbursement of the Scholarships shall be charged to the Department of Excellence Di.Gi. project, UGOV project “DIPARTIMENTO_ECCELLENZA, GIURISPRUDENZA, 2023–2027 – Project Departments of Excellence, 2023–2027 Department of Law. Art. 1, paragraphs 314 to 337, Law 232/2016”.
