The speaker will present the Brussels I Regulation from 2012 which builds upon the Brussels Convention from 1968 and discuss the principles of interpretation of this Regulation and EU Private International Law in general that the CJUE has developed over the last 50 years. A few landmark judgments of the CJUE will also be presented and discussed.

Peter Arnt Nielsen is Professor at the Copenhagen Business School and External Professor at the College of Europe, Bruges. He conducts research in and teaches Danish and International Arbitration, Mediation, and Litigation, and Danish and International Contract Law.

He is and has been member of several national and international legislative committees and working groups in the European Union, including those on the Brussels I Regulation (1998-2001, 2010-2012), and the Hague Conference for Private International Law, including those on the 2005 Choice of Court Convention (1999-2005) and the 2019 Judgments Convention (2016-2019).
