





## **ACCOBAMS Course for Highly Qualified Marine Mammals** Observers (MMO) and Passive Acoustic Monitoring operators (PAM)

Oceanomare Delphis and CIBRA, under the agreement signed with ACCOBAMS (Agreement on the Conservation of Cetaceans in the Black Sea, the Mediterranean Sea and contiguous Atlantic area), organize a new training course to qualify individuals as Marine Mammal Observers and operators of Passive Acoustic Monitoring systems.

The ACCOBAMS certification qualifies people to work as MMOs/PAM operators throughout the Mediterranean and the Black Sea in 24 countries, where it is the agreed course requirement for such work. After the course, The ACCOBAMS highly qualified MMO/PAM operators will be able to work to minimize the impact of noise on cetaceans, by applying the knowledge, expertise, and skills acquired during the training course, and using the standard procedures, forms, and manuals, following the ACCOBAMS principles.
