Educational Background Requirements	<p>To be admitted to the Master's Degree Course in Management Engineering of the University of Palermo, it is necessary to own a Bachelor Degree in Engineering (any type of specialization) from a University recognized as suitable by the University of Palermo.</p> <p>Furthermore, basic knowledge of the following areas of knowledge is required¹:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Economics • Statistics • Production technologies • Operations and Production Management <p>Details about the areas of knowledge are described in the Master Program website.</p>
Methods of admission and assessment of applicant's knowledge	<p>The applicant will only be admitted if he/she gets a positive evaluation from the Admission Committee through an interview aimed at assessing the level of basic knowledge to the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Economics • Statistics • Production technologies • Operations and Production Management <p>The Admission Committee is appointed by the Master Program Council. The detailed instructions and dates of the interview, applicants should visit the Master Program website (page "Enrolment") Before attending the interview, applicant are required to prepare themselves according to the instructions and the teaching material as indicated Master Program website (page "Enrolment").</p> <p>Students must also demonstrate to know English language, in writing, reading, listening and speaking, with a level at least equal to B2 of the CEFR. The level of knowledge of the Italian language will also be assessed and, where necessary, teaching will be activated in the context of further linguistic knowledge.</p>
NOTES	<p>¹ For the purposes of assessing the curricular requirements, the Master Program Council will appoint a specific Admission Committee which will evaluate the study plan of the students who intend to access.</p>
