

Rūta Banelienė is an Associate Professor at the Department of Mechanical and Materials Engineering of Vilnius Gediminas Technical University in Lithuania. She started her professional career as a chief economist in 2002 at the Fiscal Policy Department of the Ministry of Finance. In 2006, she became the head of the EU Division. She has been a member of several working groups, including the Ageing Working Group of the Economic Policy Committee of the Council of the EU, and the European Commission's working groups on economic policy formation and evaluation, such as Structures of the Taxation System, Public Administration Network (PAN II), and EuroTeam. In 2008, she began working as an adviser on EU and international affairs in the field of economics, energy, foreign policy, and international cooperation at the Prime Minister's office. Over the past decade, she has published numerous books and research papers with a clear focus on innovation and its impact on economic growth.
