Based Regulated Grammars

This talk outlines an important area of formal language theory - regulated grammars. These grammars work like classical context-free grammars, but they regulate the use of their rules by some simple mathematical mechanisms, such as binary relations. The talk gives several concepts of this grammatical regulation, including matrix and programmed grammars. In its conclusion, the talk formulates several open problems and suggests future investigation areas.
