Seminar on Systematic Review

The training course is structured into four sessions, each dedicated to the main phases of conducting a systematic literature review.

The **first session** introduces the definition of a systematic review, its differences from other types of reviews, and the PICO framework for formulating a research question. It also covers the use of major databases (Scopus, Web of Science), with hands-on search exercises.

The **second session** focuses on the selection of studies and the assessment of their quality, using inclusion/exclusion criteria, evaluation tools, and discussion of potential biases and confounding factors. The **third session** delves into data extraction, with particular attention to planning and the use of specific extraction forms, followed by a guided practical exercise.

The **fourth session** addresses data analysis methods (qualitative analysis and basic concepts of metaanalysis), and provides guidance on report writing according to the PRISMA Statement. The course concludes with a final workshop dedicated to drafting the systematic review report.

Seminar - The Research Cycle

The seminar provides both a theoretical and practical foundation for designing a research project, through an integrated approach that combines lectures and hands-on activities.

In the **first session**, the research cycle is analyzed and applied through a practical exercise.

The **second session** focuses on the actual design of the research project, followed by a workshop. In the **third session**, participants present and discuss their projects in a collaborative feedback session.
