

Ciclo di seminari

Social Perspectives on Cognition, Knowledge and Learning (3 maggio ore 15-18 aula Ex Ufficio A Edif. 19)

In Western philosophy and science, cognition and knowledge have traditionally been understood as mental phenomena located in the individual mind. The intrapsychological view still dominates contemporary cognitive science and Second Language Acquisition, but alternative proposals are strongly gaining ground. The seminar examines cognition and knowledge as discursive and embodied matters. Starting with the observation that “psychological” states and processes are on constant display in social interaction, we will examine how participants display and construct understanding, knowing, and learning as socially constituted, occasioned through talk, and deployed for practical purposes.

Emotion in Multilingual Interaction (24 maggio ore 14-17 aula Seminari A Edif. 19)

In the social sciences and humanities, emotions have predominantly been treated as intrapsychological and neurophysiological phenomena, though not without challenge. In contrast, converging perspectives from ethnomethodology, conversation analysis, and linguistic anthropology respecify emotion as socially constituted, discursively produced, and publicly displayed by participants for each other on specific occasions in their interaction. This seminar will examine how participants in diverse social activities mobilize a wide range of semiotic resources in the production of affective stance and what interactional consequences such exhibits engender.
