

The Bachelor in Philosophical and Historical Studies aims to provide students with a solid knowledge of history and philosophy from antiquity to the present day. It is characterized by a particular attention to contemporary research tending to form in the student the disposition to recognize the linguistic-conceptual structures operating in cultural-historical processes.

The bachelor is divided into historical and philosophical curricula, and includes the first three semesters of common training and the other three of curricular training. During the course the students acquire competence on the variety of methods and tools for philosophical and historical research. The student is encouraged to acquire language skills and to participate in international programme. At the end of the studies, a degree discussion will be held on a topic of students' choice.

The degree course offers different perspectives: the continuation of studies in the master degree in philosophy, history or cognitive sciences; alternatively the course provides access to cultural and editorial professions in a broad sense.
