4. Eligibility requirements

The Master's Degree Program in Tourism Systems and Hospitality Management at the University of Palermo welcomes applicants who meet specific academic and professional criteria, ensuring they have the foundational knowledge and skills to excel in this advanced program.

The program is ideal for recent graduates and professionals looking to enhance their tourism and hospitality management expertise. With its comprehensive curriculum and global focus, the program equips students to meet the challenges of a dynamic and evolving industry.

Academic Background	Applicants must hold a relevant bachelor's degree in tourism, hospitality management, economics, business administration, marketing, sociology, geography, international relations, environmental studies, cultural studies, languages, or event management, or other fields related with tourism studies. These disciplines align with the program's interdisciplinary approach, preparing students for leadership roles in tourism and hospitality.
GPA Requirements	A minimum GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent in other grading systems) is required for the bachelor's degree as follows:
B2 English Language Knowledge proof	Proof of English proficiency is mandatory, demonstrated through recognized international certificates or equivalent qualifications such as: IELTS (Minimum score of 6) -TOEFL iBT (Minimum score of 80) -DUOLINGO (Minimum score of 110) Alternatively, students without a certificate must take an online English test offered by Palermo University's Language Centre (CLA). A B2 level (25/30) is required. Applicants from countries where English is the official language are exempt from this requirement.

6. Start the application process.

6.1 Check the admission requirements.

1.1 Document: a valid passport, according to the Italian Embassy’s requirements

1.2 Bachelor’s Degree

Applicants must possess a relevant bachelor’s degree (Translated into English or Italian) in one of the following preferred fields or related to these courses:

Tourism / Hospitality Management / Economics / Languages / Business Administration / International Relations / Marketing / Sociology / Environmental Studies / Cultural Studies / Event Management / Geography

1.3 Transcript of Records

A valid Transcript of Records (Translated into English or Italian) from the university where you obtained your bachelor’s degree should be uploaded along with other documents during the application process.

1.4 Bachelor’s degree grade

Applicants are advised to have a minimum grade for their bachelor’s degree. Please see the (Grade Point Average (GPA) on your bachelor’s degree certificate, which should be 3.0 or more to qualify for admission into the program. For GPA conversion for some countries, see the table below:

1.5 B2 English Language knowledge certificate

To be admitted, you must have a certified B2 level in the English language ONLY from an internationally recognised English academy, such as TOEFL or IELTS.

The certificate should be valid and not issued more than 2 years before the application, and the score should be a minimum score of TOEFL iBT: 80 - TOEFL PBT: 550 - IELTS: 6.0 Duolingo: 110.

Suppose you studied in an international university in an English language course and do not have one of the mentioned English language certificates. In that case, you can take the online English test at Palermo University Language Center (Centro Linguistico d'Ateneo online – CLA: <https://www.unipa.it/strutture/cla/>).

To attend it, you must book the test online at the following link:

You will receive an email containing the link to the test 24 hours before your exam starts.

The test is multiple-choice and can be practised through the ROSETTA STONE platform, depending on the level you need to reach. The link is:

To be certified at a B2 English level, your score should be over 25/30.

1.6 A Curriculum Vitae

Please submit a clear and well-organized CV with a good-quality recent photo. Ensure your CV includes your education, skills, and any experience related to the master's program and your previous education.

1.7 A Motivation letter

A limited motivation letter should be written in the application process. Please ensure that you have included the most critical factors that motivate you to select the Master in Tourism Systems and Hospitality Management. Please pay attention to spelling and grammar.

6.2 Start the online application.

After reviewing the requirements, you can begin your application by completing the online application form. Please ensure that all required documents are submitted to facilitate a smooth application process.

The Italian tax code (Codice Fiscale) is a unique identifier required for university enrollment and other official processes. International students can apply for it online through the Italian Revenue Agency's website and finalise their registration upon arrival in Italy.

6.3 Check your knowledge of the tourism field by attending the Test.

Once you meet the application requirements, the program coordinator will send an email inviting you to participate in the entry test and interview for the Master's in Tourism Systems and Hospitality Management. If you are accepted, you will be issued a formal admission letter, which can be used to support your visa application.

The Entry Test is essential and mandatory to our admission process and is designed to assess your attitude and suitability for the course.

The multiple-choice test is finalised to verify your basic knowledge of Tourism Concepts and Issues. You can consider the following material: Tourism Theory, Concepts, Models, and Systems.

Entry Test exemption: For International students with specific bachelor's degrees

International students with a bachelor's degree in Tourism and Hospitality are exempt from the Entry Test for the program.

6.4 Check your motivation and your future as a tourism professional with the Interview.

After the English and Entry test, the enrolment commission may invite you for an online interview. This interview allows the admissions commission to get to know you better and understand your study goals in this course. They will discuss your motivations and aspirations in tourism and hospitality, ensuring that your objectives align with the program's offerings.

6.5 University application

After completing your application and getting the final admission letter, you can register on the University portal (<https://www.university.it>) with this letter.

The University application (for the academic year 2025-2026) starts from March till 30 August 2025. This process is only for those students who have already started an application on the UNIPA student portal.

The required documents for University:

- a valid passport
- a passport photo
- a copy of your bachelor's degree (please note that provisional certificates are not acceptable),
- a Legalized Translated Transcript of Records
- an official Language Certification (B2 level or higher) or a Medium of Instruction certificate from your institution

6.6 Tuition fee

Tuition fees are adjusted to the family's economic situation (ISEE PARIFICATO).

The tuition fee is composed of two parts:

1. Fixed Fee: €156 (€140 Regional Tax and €16 duty stamp);
2. Variable Fee: Amount calculated based on the student's income. To utilise this option, international students with a resident family abroad must provide certain financial documents (ISEE PARIFICATO):
 - a. Family income from 01/2022 to 12/2022

- b. Family bank account statements until 31/12/2022, and personal bank account statements in Italy, if applicable, until 31/12/2022
- c. Family status of 2024 (number of members)
- d. Property papers of 2024

*It should be noted that during your application (when you are in your own country), you do not need to have ISEE; after your arrival, you can go to the CAF offices to get your ISEE with the mentioned documents.

When in Italy, you must have an ISEE Certification to define your scholarship application, when you arrive in Italy (see scholarship application)

Then, upload it to your ERSU portal.

* A CAF office is conveniently located right in front of the university, where you can easily book an appointment via WhatsApp to request your ISEE.

6.7 Scholarship

You can apply for a scholarship through ERSU di Palermo,

Accommodation: Housing is provided starting in October to ensure students have a stable living situation.

Meal Provisions: Students can enjoy complimentary meals at university cafeterias.

Financial Aid: Additional cash support may be available based on specific financial needs.

You must get the ISEE number from the CAF offices to get the scholarship. After you arrive in Palermo, you can get it and then upload it on the ERSU portal.

The tuition fee depends on your family's economic situation.

*There is a CAF office in front of the university where you can get your ISEE number.

6.8 Visa Process

To apply for an Italian student visa for the master's program, students typically need the following documents. Please note that these requirements may vary depending on the applicant's home country and the specific Italian embassy or consulate:

- Completed Visa Application Form – Filled out and signed
- Valid Passport – Must be valid for at least six months beyond the intended stay in Italy.
- Passport-Sized Photos – Recent photos that meet visa specifications
- Proof of Enrollment – Official acceptance or enrollment letter from the Italian university
- Proof of Financial Means – Bank statements or a financial guarantee to show sufficient funds to support your stay
- Health Insurance – Coverage for medical expenses during your stay in Italy
- Proof of Accommodation – Documentation showing where you will stay (university housing, private rental, etc.)
- Flight Reservation – Proof of booked travel to and from Italy
- Academic Transcripts and Diplomas – Certified copies of prior academic records and qualifications
- University Summary – The summary or confirmation document generated on the University portal after completing your pre-enrollment application.

To request a study permit visa, you must contact the Italian embassy in your country. You can find information about the Italian embassies in your countries in the link below.

Notice: The university only issues the admission letter for your visa application, and we are not permitted to interfere in the visa process, as it is handled entirely by the embassy.

6.9 Finalising the Enrolment

Please submit your documents to the Secretary's Office to finalise your enrollment. Required documents typically include your academic records, such as your bachelor's degree certificate, transcript of records, and the Dichiarazione di Valore (DOV). You may also need to provide a copy of your passport, visa, and any other specific documents requested by the university. Then, you are allowed to follow the lectures.
