

VADEMECUM FOR THE ADMISSION TEST FOR THE MASTER'S DEGREE IN TOURISM SYSTEMS AND HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT (LM-49)

The admission test for the Master's Degree in Tourism Systems and Hospitality Management (LM-49) will be a **written test** focused on:

- a) English language proficiency** - Candidates who have a B2 proficiency certification (issued by an appropriate certifying body) or who are native English speakers are **exempted** from the English language proficiency test.
- b) Assessment of individual groundings** - educational background and awareness in applying prior knowledge to the educational objectives of the course.
- c) Motivation and expectations.**

<p>Curricular requirements</p>	<p>Since the course is held entirely in English, candidates are required to have an adequate knowledge of the English language and therefore at least an English B2 proficiency level (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). This requirement is considered as fulfilled by those candidates who have a B2 proficiency certification (issued by an appropriate certifying body) or who are native English speakers.</p> <p>The mandatory curricular requirements will be assessed through an admission test, carried out by a specifically appointed commission. The Commission may take into consideration also the work experience and training activities resulting from the candidate's curriculum vitae.</p>
<p>Assessment of individual groundings</p>	<p>Candidates who meet the curricular requirements will take an admission test aimed at facilitating their subsequent integration into the course. The admission test will be an interview or a written test and will be carried out by a specifically appointed commission which will assess whether the student possesses the two conditions specified below:</p> <p>1) adequate knowledge of the English language - this requirement is considered as fulfilled by those candidates who have a B2 proficiency certification (issued by an appropriate certifying body) or who are native English speakers;</p> <p>2) knowledge similar to those of the Italian degree classes (L-15 Scienze del turismo, L-16 Scienze dell'amministrazione e dell'organizzazione, L-18 Scienze dell'economia e della gestione aziendale, L 33 Scienze economiche, L-36 Scienze politiche e delle relazioni internazionali, L 37 Scienze sociali per la Cooperazione, lo sviluppo e la pace, L-39 Servizio sociale, L-40 Sociologia, L-41 Statistica), OR knowledge assessed as adequate by the Commission.</p>
