Alberto Del Bimbo is Emeritus Professor of Computer Engineering at the University of Firenze, Italy. He has served as *Director* of the Department of Systems and Informatics (Dipartimento di Sistemi e Informatica), of the Master in Multimedia, and of the Media Integration and Communication Center. He was also *Deputy Rector* for Research and Innovation Transfer and *President* of the Foundation for Research and Innovation of the University of Firenze.

He is the author of over 500 scientific publications in Computer Vision, Multimedia Analysis and Artificial Intelligence that appeared in some of the most prestigious scientific journals and conference proceedings. He has served as the Associate Editor of IEEE Transactions on Pattern Analysis and Machine Intelligence and IEEE Transactions on Multimedia and Editor in Chief of ACM Transactions on Multimedia Computing, Communications, and Applications, Pattern Recognition and Multimedia Tools and Applications. He was the *General Chair of* IEEE ICMCS 1999, the International Conference on Multimedia Computing and Systems, ACM MULTIMEDIA 2010, the International Conference on Multimedia, ACM ICMR 2011, the International Conference on Multimedia Retrieval, ECCV 2012, the European Conference on Computer Vision, ICPR 2020, the International Conference on Pattern Recognition, and ACM MULTIMEDIA 2022, and the *Program Chair* of many other highly ranked international conferences. He has been the leading person of international and national projects and the scientific advisor of institutions and companies.

In 2016, he was recognized by the international Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) as ACM *Distinguished Scientist, "in recognition of significant accomplishments in and impact on the computing field*". Alberto Del Bimbo is currently the *Chair* of ACM SIGMM, the global Special Interest Group on Multimedia of the Association for Computing Machinery.
