









CONCORSO DI IDEE Ideas Contest

INCLUDI...AMO PROJECT

The Didactic Department "Paolo Vetri" in Ragusa with headquarter of the Territorial Center of Support and Leadership of *Rete Provinciale per l'Inclusione*, made up in 2016, that includes 40 schools of the first and second cycle of the province of Ragusa, was the winner of the call for "Inclusione e Disabilità", set up by MIUR, with didactic project "Includi...Amo".

The project proposes actions to transform learning environments and build a support network in schools and between schools, between schools and the territory. Among the interventions envisaged in the project there is the design and implementation of inclusive environments within each school institution.

ORGANIZING BODY

The Didactic Department "Paolo Vetri", in collaboration with l'Ordine degli Architetti P.P.C. of Ragusa, Farm Cultural Park, SOU Scuola di Architettura per Bambini, in the implementation of the project "Includi...Amo".

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT "INCLUDI...AMO"

The reality in which schools work requires to reformulate their organization, their design and their teaching methodology to meet the needs of all pupils. School institutions are called upon to adopt a "policy of inclusion" as a social strategy and training course to provide effective and efficient responses.

The project arises from the need to redefine the learning environment as a whole and in its various joints:

- a) the physical environment, with forms of more flexible space organization to promote communication and socialization processes;
- b) the communicative-relational environment, as a background of emotional and socio-affective factors to promote the collaboration, autonomy and responsibility of each;
- c) the educational environment as an action space created to stimulate knowledge building.

The design proposal should promote and consolidate the process of inclusion of pupils with disabilities and / or specific learning disabilities with a view to ethical and fundamental policy choices aimed at building a more equitable society.

An inclusive system considers the pupil as the protagonist of learning, regardless of its capabilities, potentialities and limits. The active building of knowledge should therefore be promoted by activating personal approaches to "knowing", respecting rhythms and learning styles and "self-regulation" mechanisms.

THE DATA PLANNING

Each participant can imagine a "Type Environment" an Hall, a Corridor, an Atrium, an External Space. It will be his/her discretion to choose between:

- a 50 square meters hall with a height of 3 m;
- 300 square meters of an Atrium / Communal Space for a height of 6 m;
- an External Space pertaining to the school of 300 square meters.

Such surfaces may be applied, by choice, to:

- Primary and Secondary School of First and Second Degree.

The design idea can be developed in the light of the adaptability to the existing school heritage.

The design should include permanent or temporary modular furniture elements, or interfere with the senses by using visual arts, sound, etc.

It is given maximum freedom to candidates to express their creativity in order to reach the goal of creating inclusive environments in schools.

Suggestions will be appreciated for the use of environmentally friendly materials.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

The call is open to all creators, artists, architects and non-speakers, who have great sensitivity to the themes of the contest. It will be able to participate individually or in groups (a sheet will be added to each group participant).

REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION

The registration and participation in the contest of ideas and the context of the submission of the requested elaboration.

Candidates must submit, electronically:

- the registration form (attached to the notice), signed in pdf format;
- a table, horizontal A1 format, in pdf format;

to e-mail address: include.rg@gmail.com, by no later than 00.00 on 19/11/2017.

To ensure anonymity, they must contain in the name of the file and within the table an alphanumeric 5-digit code, chosen by the participant.

It will take care of the Order of Architects P.P.C. of Ragusa, send the boards to the Jury, withholding the registration cards.

The elaborate can be realized with free representation technique: texts, photos, drawings, sketches, etc.

The candidate will nominate the tables according to the example to follow.

THE PRIZES

The first runner-up, proclaimed by the Jury, will receive a cash prize of € 1,000.00. The Jury may also give special mention.



After the jury's work is completed, the boards will be published on the facebook page "Includi Amo-Ragusa" for the award of the "Social Prize" ("**Premio Social**").

The winners and those mentioned will be invited to exhibit the project at the round table which will take place in the presence of jurors and experts at the auditorium of the Institute "G. B. Vico - Umberto I - R. Gagliardi".
