





### **HOW TO GET TO DIJON?**

**By plane**: the nearest airports to Dijon are the ones of Paris, Lyon, Dole, Mulhouse, Strasbourg and Geneva. In order to get to Dijon from these cities, you can either take a train, bus or rent a car.

By train: Dijon is served with high-speed train (TGV) from Paris (1h35), Paris Charles de Gaulle airport (1h35), Lyon (1h45), Mulhouse (1h05), Strasbourg (2h), Geneva (2h40), and regional slow train from Dole (30 min). We advise you to book your train ticket in advance on the railway company SNCF website.

**By bus**: there are a few bus companies serving Dijon, such as Flixbus, Ouibus and Isilines.

**By car**: there are many routes, from Paris, from Lyon, from Dole, from Mulhouse, from Strasbourg, and from Geneva.







#### **HOW TO GET TO THE UNIVERSITY?**

From Dijon-Ville train station, take tramway no. 1 from the station ("Dijon Gare" stop) towards "Quetigny Centre".



You can buy a tramway ticket from the machine at the stop, or pay with a contactless bank card inside the tram ( <a href="https://www.divia.fr/bus-tram/open-payment">https://www.divia.fr/bus-tram/open-payment</a>).

Get off the tramway at the "Erasme" stop (the tramway journey takes 20 minutes maximum). Once off the tramway, use the following maps to get to the Language Centre. Cross the esplanade and go to the extension of the 3Droit/Lettres" (Law/Literature) building, then go up to the 3rd floor to office n°360.
