1. GOALS

As part of the initiative funded by the Italian Ministry for University and Research (MUR) Transnational Education project MARE [Mediterranean Alliance for Research and Education](#), coordinated by the University of Palermo and aimed at strengthening relations between Italian universities and Mediterranean Area universities, Palermo University promotes the organization of an high-level training course on focus and insights into the specific themes covered by the Project Mare from 18th to 22th May 2026 in Palermo.
