WELCOME ADDRESS



Founded in 1806, the University of Palermo is a powerful scientific and cultural engine. With more than 40,000 students, 3,000 professors and technical-administrative staff, 128 buildings in downtown and in the University Campuses in Agrigento, Caltanissetta and Trapani, UniPA has the dimension of a mega dynamic University, aimed to generate culture, research, innovation, training to work and, more generally, to promote the development of the society and the territory.

The University of Palermo has 16 Departments, and offers 131 Bachelor and Master Degree courses and 19 PhD courses, covering almost all the fields of knowledge and opening lots of work opportunities, based on very high standards of study and excellence.

Medicine, Basic and Applied Sciences, Law, Political and Social Studies, Economy, Food and Agricultural Sciences, Architecture, Engineering, Arts, Cultural Heritage, Communication Sciences, represent just a few examples of the wide education and research panel of the University of Palermo.

UniPA is strongly involved into internationalization: 46 double degree or joint degree courses are proposed, in connection with Universities worldwide and 9 courses are offered entirely in English. Furthermore, UniPA has signed an impressive number of MoUs and Networking agreements with foreign Universities: as far as Erasmus mobility program is concerned, more than 600 agreements have been signed, involving almost 1500 incoming or outgoing students per year. UniPA is a modern Institution deeply active for student's placement, thanks to an up-to-date Job Placement Service; as well, throughout a start-up incubator, the University encourages the creation of new companies, based on innovation and knowledge.

Several famous professors made the history and the fame of the University: among them the current President of the Italian Republic, Prof. Sergio Mattarella, who taught Parliamentary Law, the chemist Stanislao Cannizzaro and the physicist Emilio Segrè, Nobel Prize in Physics in 1959. Many well distinguished scholars in the scientific, cultural and political field: among them the architect Giovan Battista Filippo Basile, the doctor Maurizio Ascoli, the anthropologist Giuseppe Pitrè and the judges Giovanni Falcone and Paolo Borsellino.

UniPa is a famous and historical University in a beautiful and student-friendly city, which is: rich in history, overlooking the sea and one of the main Italian tourist destinations for its stunning cultural sites.

The City and the University are closely connected in a strong institutional co-operation, based on those cultural, historical, civil and hospitality values that make Palermo a special and unique place in the world.

Palermo is historically the crossroad of the Mediterranean people. Lifestyle, culture, food are the result of a crossover of stories and cultures with ancient origins that have developed a tradition of hospitality and integration over the years. Aware of this role, the University of Palermo wants to be more and more a meeting point for young people of different nationalities.

UniPA provides a network of services that, at different levels, support students during their University career: COT is the Guidance and Tutoring Center; CLA is the University Language Center, ITAS-TRA is the Italian Language School for foreigners; CLEDU is the Legal Clinic of Human Rights for legal support; AMU is the University Medical Clinic to assist students. Furthermore, the University seeks to address the needs of students with disabilities through transport services, personal assistance services, peer tutoring services.



UniPa provides a special program enabling the access to bachelor and master degrees to young asylum seekers or international protection holders, in compliance with the Treaty of Lisbon.

Finally, in order to guarantee the exercise of the gender identity right, as a fundamental element of the personal identity rights, and to create a positive working and learning environment inspired by principles of correctness and mutual respect for freedom and personal dignity, the University of Palermo has issued an "Alias student regulation", allowing students, who have undergone gender reassignment, to have an "alias" identity corresponding to their external appearance, to be used for all internal University procedures.

International Students Mobility

UniPa offers the possibility to carry out study periods abroad, within the European area:

- ► with the Erasmus student status under the Erasmus+ Program;
- with the visiting student status.

Erasmus+ study aims

The Erasmus+ program allows to spend part of the University courses - from three to twelve months - in another European country. With the "Erasmus + student status," It is possible to attend courses, take exams, carry out internships, prepare the final thesis and acquire the related credits for the developed activities. **The Erasmus+ for Traineeship Program** allows students and recent graduates to carry out training courses, from two to twelve months, in companies, training and research centers in one of the countries participating in the Program.

International educational programs and regulations

The University implements courses in English, also in collaboration with universities or foreign institutions, with an international profile in terms of educational objectives, skills and contents. It also develops programs with an integrated study approach and disciplinary networks, aiming as well at a joint acknowledgment of its degrees.

ARCA is an incubator in the UNiPa campus, promoting industrial research and technological transfer programs for the needs of small and medium-sized enterprises, networks and industrial districts.

The Advanced Technologies Network Center (ATeN) is another important initiative carried out by UNipa under the Third Mission actions. The Advanced Technologies Network Center (ATeN) is one of the few research and development centers in the world in the field of Biotechnology applied to human health, offering services ranging from the synthesis of materials to in vivo tests with its 23 certified laboratories.

The Industrial Liason Office (ILO) develops links between the University of Palermo and the economic and productive local community.

Example of excellence, the UniPa Museums Network includes six thematic museums and many Department collections. It is also in charge of the management of archaeological and artistic sites of high and great value.

Collections and Museums are part of the University Museums Network (SIMUA) set up in 2017, whose headquarter is located in the Botanical Garden of Palermo, the jewel of the museum system, planted in 1789 and hosting a wide variety of Mediterranean and tropical flora.

The University Museums Network aims to spread the knowledge of the cultural heritage even beyond its own walls, towards the civil society, as a form of civic mission and investment in the territory and for the territory, according to the idea that investing in culture is the best way to empower the territory and the development.





The University Headquarter is located in the historical site of Palazzo Chiaromonte – Steri, that is one of the buildings of greatest historical and artistic interest in Palermo. Built in 1320, between 1468 and 1517 it housed the Spanish viceroys and between 1601 and 1782 it was the location of the Inquisition Court. During this period the building was adapted to this function with prisons, nowadays open for public visits.



UNIVERSITY MUSEUMS NETWORK



The University Museums Network is made up of: the Botanical Garden; Pietro Doderlein Museum of Zoology, founded in the second half of the nineteenth century; the Museum of Geology G. G. Gemellaro, hosting more than 600 thousand artefacts, shared in several geological and paleontological collections; the Astronomical Observatory Museum La Specola founded in 1790 by Ferdinando di Borbone; the Historical Museum of Engine and Mechanisms; the Museum of Radiology.

Furthermore, the University Museums Network manages thirteen collections and the ancient Monastery of Sant'Antonino.

THE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY AND HISTORICAL ARCHIVE NETWORK

The University Library and Historical Archive Network includes libraries, resources, tools and services offered by the Libraries of the University of Palermo. It includes 21 libraries, including 2 in Agrigento and Trapani, collected in 5 library centers, for a total of 44 services desks.



The University of Palermo manages several libraries throughout the University Library and Historical Archive Network.

The libraries of the University of Palermo provide students with access and consultation on site, documents and inter-library loan and bibliographical consultation. There is also an online booking service with which it is possible to book online books for consultation or for loan, saving time at the front-office desk.

Through a single search interface, UniPa Discovery service releases information on papers availability (online or in paper) in the collections of UniPa libraries and allows to access a list of results useful for own bibliographic searches:
