Internships and Laboratories

During the three course years, students will be in touch with the real world of health, with those who suffer and need help to overcome obstacles. They will thus have the opportunity for an unparalleled professional and human growth; they will learn to integrate theoretical knowledge with operational and organizational procedures, critical thinking with human skills, experimentation with the real assistance context.

Students, before being admitted to the wards, will practice in the laboratory, having the opportunity to train in a controlled environment, and to experiment what they have learned in class, applying the theoretical principles to clinical practice so as to develop:

- technical and practical skills through the use of simulators;
- care, organizational, relational and problem solving skills by applying care methodologies, thanks to the use of simulated clinical cases written with patients, families and health professionals.



Graduates in Nursing are health care professionals carryoing out, with professional autonomy, activities aimed at prevention, care and safeguarding individual and collective health, with respect to the functions identified by the professional profile as well as the deontological cose and using planning methodologies for assistance in the developmental age, as well as in adults and the elderly.

What are your duties within the hospital team?



Nurses are healthcare professionals in charge of general preventive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative and technical, relational and educational nursing activities.

The main functions are disease prevention, care for the sick and disabled persons of all ages and health education

In addition, nurses:

 Participate to the identification of individual and community health needs an to the formulation of the related objectives; Plan, manage and evaluate the nursing care interventions, ensuring the correct application of diagnostic-therapeutic prescriptions, acting individually or in collaboration with other health and social workers.

What are the job opportunities?

Nurses carry out their professional activity in public or private health care facilities, in the territory, and in home care, as employees or freelance; they contribute to the training of support personnel and are able to update their professional profile and research.
