I am currently involved in EU Horizon project proposal under HORIZON-CL2-2026-01-TRANSFO-06-call: "Making Europe a global magnet for talent - Attracting and retaining students, researchers and high-skilled workers from outside the EU". The proposal is coordinated by Häme University of Applied Sciences, Finland. The working title of our research proposal is "Designing sustainable attraction and retention for higher education students and future high-skilled workers in the non-capital regions of Europe". We are currently planning scaling up activities for the project proposal and are currently thinking of an option to do this through European University alliance partners of consortium members.
