Accommodation

<u>FOR CAMPUS OLTEN:</u> All exchange students who have applied for accommodation at the FHNW will be allocated a single room at the student residence, Staff House or at FHNW partnership with the residence hall Franziskushaus.

- Deposit payment: 150 Swiss francs
- Monthly rent:
 - staff house CHF 400.- per month
 - Franziskushaus: CHF 450.- per month
- Cleaning charge:
 - A one-time cleaning charge is to be paid together with the first monthly payment (staff house: CHF 100.-/Franziskushaus: CHF 50.-)

<u>FOR BASEL:</u> All accommodation placements work via the accommodation service of the University of Basel, WoVe. When international students are accepted for a course of study or exchange semester, they can register with the student accommodation centre WoVe. For a small fee, this organisation will assist in the finding of a separate furnished room or studio, or a room within a communal flat. The rental for such accommodation is between CHF 300 - 900 per month.

<u>FOR BRUGG:</u> The International Office arranges accommodation for exchange students. There is a choice of homestays or shared flat accommodation. - Official transcript of grades
- Evidence of finances: The financial proof is an approximation of costs students will have in Switzerland during their stay and it must be calculated by them. We cannot say an exact quantity

because it varies according to the number of semesters the student stays and also it depends on your expenses. In order to support incoming students on estimate this average, in our Fact Sheet there is a paragraph called "Cost of Living" which shows approximate expenses.
